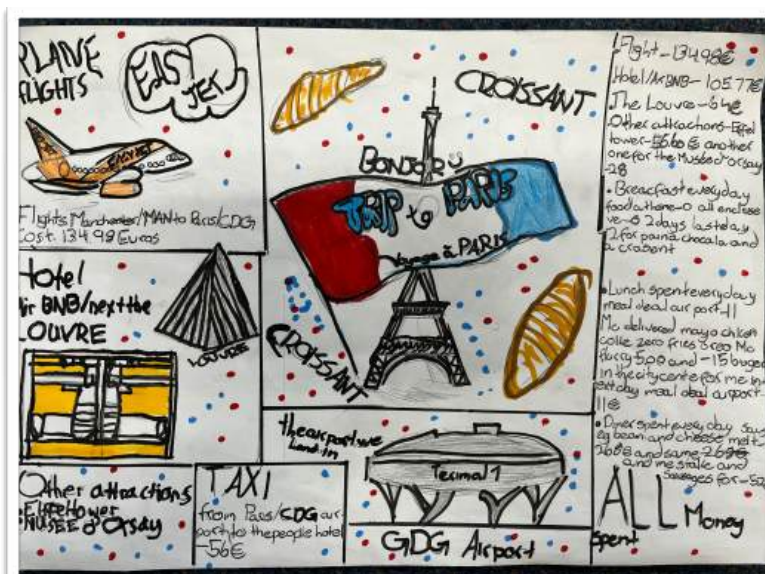
I hope this week's newsletter finds you well.

Thank you for all the bottles and chocolates that were brought in today for next Friday's Summer Fayre. There are some very good prizes for the tombolas!

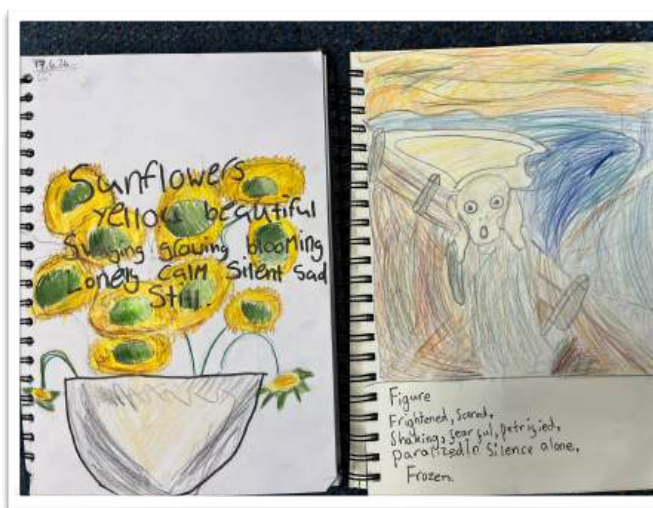
