We are aiming for all our pupils to achieve an average of 97% attendance a year (6 days absence).

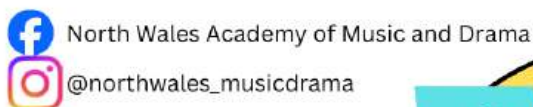

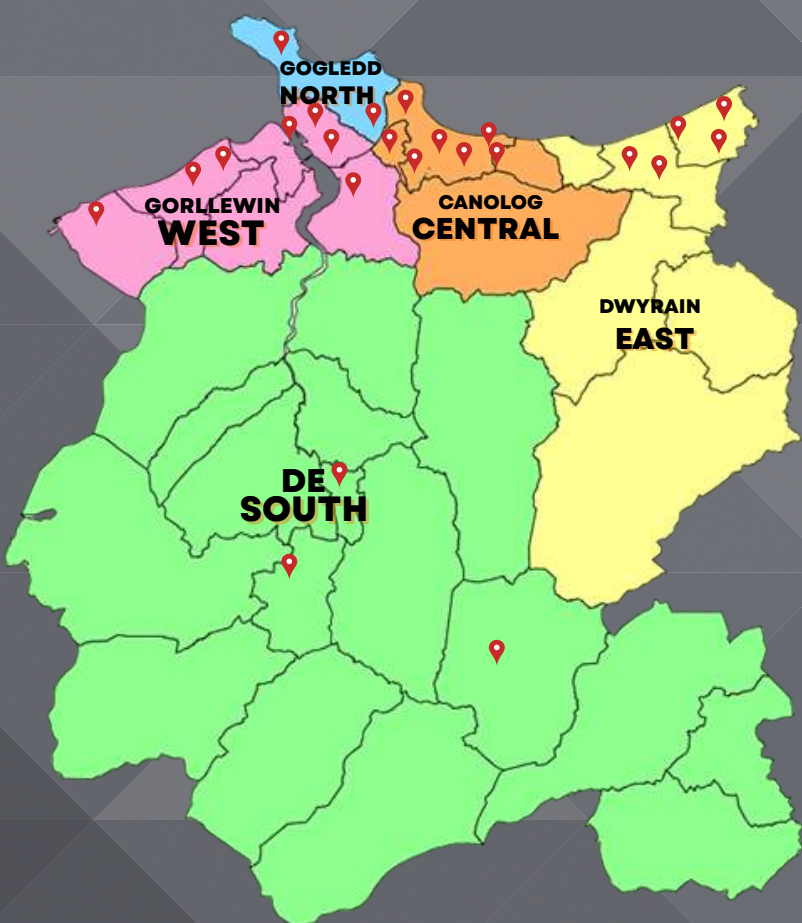
