Friends Christmas Fair

A note for your diary - our Christmas Fair is on Friday 6th December 3:30pm-5:30pm where Santa will be making a special visit with his reindeer. A fun event for all the family full of festive spirit!

‘Dangerpoint Rangers’. These rangers gave background information to the dangers encountered by the children in each zone.

In one zone (pictured above) the children looked for dangers that you may encounter along the coastline and at the beach. In another zone (pictured below), the groups looked at road safety matters, including using pedestrian crossings safely, whether you were a pedestrian or cyclist. Before leaving the centre, the children re-took the quiz from earlier in the day to see if they could improve their scores due to the information learnt on their tour. Year 6 scored an impressive 86%, with the rangers stating it was one of the best scores they’ve had from a school all year! Once again, all the children were praised by the staff for their attention and good behaviour - with many at the centre stating that they were a credit to the school.
