What a week of learning! This week in 2LC we have been making discoveries about the Islamic festival of Ramadan. We have learned about the importance of this celebration and the reasons behind some of the traditions that occur during the month of fasting - sawm, which focuses on prayer and community. We have also been making connections in our maths sessions. Our focus has been adding and subtracting 9 using a strategy of adding/subtracting 10 initially.
